Notes:

1. Vice President Seibure welcomed the committee members to the special executive committee session and indicated the purpose for which the members were asked to attend. On September 1, 2021 an email letter was sent to Mrs. Thelma Crusoe-Holmes chair of Cathedral School Education Foundation (CSEF) with immediate effect. This facilitated a discussion among the committee members and has to be resolved. The Executive Committee has a duty to interpret the article as per the 1996 constitution until at such time it is amended.
2. Article VII Cathedral School Education Foundation
  - a. **Section 7.3:** The Chair of the Education Foundation shall be appointed by the president of the association. He / She may be removed by a majority vote of the Executive Committee of the association.

3. Article IV Qualification for and Election of Officers
  - a. **Section 4.3: Removal:** An officer may be removed with cause by a vote of a majority of the Executive Committee of the association, or with or without cause by a vote of a majority of the members of the association. An officer may be removed with cause only after reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard.
  - b. **Section 4.4: Resignation:** An officer may resign by delivering his / her written resignation to the president or to a meeting of the members or Executive Committee. Such resignation shall be effective upon receipt (unless specified to be effective at some other time), and acceptance thereof shall not be necessary to make it effective unless it so states. A resignation, death, or forfeiture of any cause or without cause, shall operate as an assignment and release to the association of all right, title, and interest of such officer and to property and estate of the association, except obligation of the association to such officer.
4. Conclusion:
  - a. President Gant withdrew her letter of termination of Mrs. Crusoe-Holmes Chairman CSEF and put before the Executive Committee her desire to replace the chairman.
  - b. President Gant asked “when does the president get the opportunity to appoint the chair of the education foundation?”
  - c. Mrs. Agatha Joseph, the previous CSAA Inc. president, will furnish a copy of the resignation letter of the past CSEF Chairman Mr. Robert J. Schwarz.
  - d. Based on each of the aforementioned articles, each of which support the other and not a stand alone article and the withdrawal by President Gant, the Executive Committee took no action.
5. Chaplin Afolabi-Jallah give the closing prayer and the meeting was adjourn by president Gant at 21:50/09:50pm.
